


<u>Scissor fobs</u> not only dress up a necessary needlework tool, but they also allow you to keep track of your scissors, much like a big keychain in your purse.

***** How to Use Counting Pins in Your Cross Stitch



Perfect your stitches with <u>a laying tool</u> or use it to ease fabric through the presser foot.



And every stitcher knows the value of a <u>needle threader</u>! Lots of colors in several shapes to choose from.



Stitch markers to mark those important points in your knitting and crochet.

The <u>knitting stitch markers</u> include a unique marker for marking the beginning of the round in circular knitting.

And the <u>stitch markers for crochet</u> are removable and flexible.
