



Blue Goddess stitched by Leigh using variegated over dyed threads.

Fabric used in the model I stitched was a Charles Craft Prefinished Bookmark.

Grid Size: 30W x 120H

Design Area: 1.06" x 5.89" (19 x 106 stitches)


